










Primary 1S - Term 1 Newsletter

	<p>Welcome to Primary1. My name is Miss Slymand and I look forward to teaching your children this year and supporting them through their Primary 1 journey. Children have settled well into school life. They have been getting used to the routines of school, getting to know each other and building friendships. We have been working hard on our fine motor skills, learning about our class charter and exploring stories.</p>

We are looking at the following rights in Primary 1.</p> <p>To share our own ideas.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Article 12 <p>To learn new things.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Article 29 <p>To have friends and join in games.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Article 15 <p>To be safe and not be hurt by anyone.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Article 19 <p>To have the time to play.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Article 31 <p>We have also looked at our responsibilities too and decided on our class rules.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">To listen to others.To concentrate and work hard.To be kind and let everyone join in.To be sensible and use kind hands, words and feet. <p>To look after the things in our class room.</p> 	<p>Numeracy and Maths</p> <p>We will be working through number recognition, number formation and counting forward and backwards from any given numbers within 10.</p> <p>Literacy and English</p> <p>We are beginning to learn our initial sounds, forming them and blending them into 3 letter words. We are also looking at rhyming words within familiar rhymes.</p> 	<p>Topic</p> <p>In Primary 1, our first topic will be feelings and emotions. This will involve the pupils exploring their own feelings and understanding the feelings of others. At the moment we are working on our class charters which relates to this topic. As well as this we will be doing a literature study. During this we will be focusing on the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears and other traditional stories.</p> 	<p>PE</p> <p>Children will have PE on: Tuesday and Thursday afternoon.
