
# Primary IG Newsletter Term 1: August - October

#### Welcome



## PI Literacy

We will begin learning basic tricky words (for example: I, to, the) and try to recognise these. We will begin using wordless story books to support our story recall and our understanding of a text.


We are focussing on building our picture detailing.
