

you need:

- 1-9 dice
- pencils and eraser

Aim for 1500 for 2 players

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Aim

In this game you both roll the dice and use the numbers to make two three-digit numbers, then add them up. Whoever gets a total closest to 1500 wins the game.

First of all

Decide who has which grid.

When it's your turn

Roll the dice and choose a space on either grid – **yours or your opponent's** – to write the number in.

The end

When both grids are full, both of you add up the three-digit numbers you have made.

Whoever gets a total closest to 1500 wins the game.

Another game

Now rub out the numbers and play again.
