A Japanese Number Puzzle

- Fill in the grid so that each column and row contains the digits 1 to 4. Each digit can be used only once in each row or column.
- In the puzzle there are sets of squares with heavy black lines around them, these are called 'cages'.
- Within each cage is a number in the top corner and the operation that will lead you towards the correct digits to use to make this number.
- For example, a three square cage with '9 x' means that you need to write three digits from 1 to 4 that multiply together to make 9.
