BEAM Maths of the Month

you need:

- 12 counters in two colours (6 of each)
- a paper clip or a bean

Connect three: money for 2 players

First of all

Decide who has which colour of counter.

Put the paper clip here.

When it is your turn

Move the paper clip one or two steps round the loop and say the amount where you land.

Put a counter on the grid, on a square showing that amount.

If there is nowhere to put your counter, move the paper clip one more step.

The rest of the game

Keep playing until your counters run out.

Both players, choose three connected counters and add up the amounts of money covered.

Who has the larger amount? They win.
